At the end of the previous school year, students of grades 3–11 went on a field trip to the nearby Taman Jaya Park in Petaling Jaya, which is known as the city's iconic green space. During the excursion, they worked in multi-class groups on various points and tasks related to environmental protection issues.

Many of the activities were conducted by students of grades 10 and 11 who had undergone special training in environmental protection concerns by a lecturer from the International School Kuala Lumpur (ISKL) in the run-up to the campaign day. Students were then tasked to pass on this knowledge to their classmates on the activity day.

Along the way from DSKL to the nearby park, the students collected more than 35kg of plastic bottles, cans and garbage. Once there, they examined water samples, painted pictures and wrote poems, solved an environmental quiz and took nature photographs.
