- **ARD-Audio as APP.** Here you will find many audio programmes and podcasts for all ages.
- **Kika**
Kika is the children's television station of the "öffentlicher Rundfunk" (public broadcaster), where you will find a large children's programme. In addition to many programmes in kind, there are films, quiz shows, etc. for children of all ages.
