Dear Parents and Teachers, dear Students,

as you know, the parents' evenings of all classes and in the kindergarten are currently taking place. Unfortunately these meetings are only possible online this year, but we still look forward to your active participation! Among other things, the parent representatives of the classes will be elected here, who will then elect the new parent council at their meeting on September 21st, 2021. Parents' work is an important pillar for our school and I hope that many parents will again volunteer to participate in this area.

Google Kalender

The Malaysian government plans to extend the vaccination offer for Covid-19 vaccinations to children aged 12 years and above in the near future. We had already informed the families concerned about this in a separate information letter. Schools were asked to forward the information about the students' possibility to be vaccinated and to create a registration list of students who would like the Covid-19 vaccination. We have already received the registrations from our students and have forwarded them accordingly. We will inform the affected families as soon as we receive more details about the implementation of the student vaccinations and the planned vaccine. At the same time, we recommend that you also follow up on other registration channels, e.g. via the MySejahtera app, as the timing of the student vaccinations has not yet been confirmed. In this context, please also check the MySejahtera App for updates.

Furthermore, all schools have been requested by the Ministry of Education (MoE) to submit regular updates on the vaccination status of staff and students. We kindly ask you to inform us if your child has already received a Covid-19 vaccination or will receive it in the future. In this case, please send us a copy of the vaccination certificate. It is our understanding that all data will be used only for MOE/MoH statistical purposes. It has not been communicated what influence the vaccination rate at the different schools has on the reopening of individual schools. Otherwise, we would like to confirm that all information on vaccinations, as well as all other data in the student files, are of course subject to confidentiality and are intended for internal school use only.

Otherwise, we confidently expect that Selangor will soon enter phase two of the National Recovery Plan and that the opening of the DSKL will then be possible again, at least for certain classes.

If you are not able to attend one of the parents' evenings, please ask the parent representatives or other parents of the respective classes to pass on the information.

The parent representatives of the classes elected at the parents' evening will then meet again on Tuesday, September 21st, 2021, to elect the parents' council for the school year 2021/22.


Reopening of the school library – and DSKL library goes online !!!
