In the meantime, the last of our new colleagues have arrived in Malaysia: Mrs. Steindl, class teacher of class 4, has already been released from quarantine, Mrs. Fößmeier, class teacher of class 5, and our new assistant teacher, Mrs. Malk, are currently still in quarantine. Once again, we would like to welcome all our colleagues to Malaysia and to the DSKL!

In the past few days, there was a surprise opportunity for our students in grades 10 - 12 to receive a Covid-19 vaccination in Cyberjaya. Many families took advantage of this opportunity, so that in these classes the majority of students are now either fully vaccinated or received their first dose. This was followed over the weekend by the additional offer for the younger students born in the years 2006 - 2009 to receive the vaccination as well. The date for the second vaccination after exactly three weeks might collide with our autumn school holidays. So please consider this when choosing the date for the first dose. We hope that all desired appointment dates can be arranged. At this point, we would like to thank all those without whose cooperation and commitment, even on the weekend, this quick realization of the vaccination appointments would not have been possible. If you are still interested in a vaccination appointment, please contact Mrs. Hontheim.

In our email last Friday, we had already informed grades 10 - 12 about the current status of the reopening of the schools.

You must have read in the news that international schools will be allowed to reopen their doors for graduating classes from October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 onwards.

However, at a meeting with the Private Education Devision of the MoE on September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, we were informed that the expat schools - which include DSKL as well as LFKL (French School Kuala Lumpur) - will not be allowed to open until phase 3 of the National Recovery Plan.

On Friday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021, a joint letter was drafted by the DSKL and the LFKL, which was then sent to the MoE on Monday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021, along with a letter of support from the German as well as the French Embassies, asking them to reconsider the decision.

The information we received from the MoE this week was unfortunately contradictory, so that we currently have no reliable statement on the reopening. According to the current status, a school reopening also for our graduating classes on October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 is unfortunately not possible, as long as Selangor is still in phase 2 of the National Recovery Plan. This is indeed very disappointing news and we are very sorry that all efforts from different sides have been unsuccessful to date.

We are continuing to talk to all decision-makers and will inform you - if necessary at short notice - as soon as there is further news on this topic.

Now to the internal news of the DSKL: As you know, the parents' evenings took place in the past weeks. The elected class parent representatives have already held their first meeting and elected the parent council for the school year 2021/22. I would like to express my sincere thanks for their willingness to support the work of the parents through their participation in the Parent Council. I congratulate all of them on their election and look forward to working together with them this school year.

Furthermore, I would like to report that a digital visit by our process facilitator, Mr. Wollenweber, took place last week. In the course of this, many online consultations were held with the various committees of the school. The visit and the cooperation with Mr. Wollenweber is especially important in view of the upcoming federal-state inspection of the DSKL in the spring, which will confirm the status of the DSKL as an "Excellent German Foreign School". A lot of preparation is necessary for this and we would like to thank Mr. Wollenweber and all colleagues involved in these preparations for their support.
