The German School Kuala Lumpur (DSKL) is a German School Abroad in Malaysia, which is subsidied by the "Zentralstelle für das Auslandsschulwesen" (ZfA/ The Central Agency for German Schools Abroad) and operated by the German School Association Malaysia (DSM).

The primary goal of DSKL is to provide its students with a high quality education based on the German education system leading to the German university entrance qualification "Abitur" (Deutsches Internationales Abitur). Apart from focusing on academic excellence, we provide opportunities for our students to engage in intercultural experiences by familiarizing themselves with the history, culture and everyday life of our host country Malaysia.









Children of all nationalities with adequate German language proficiency can become a student at the DSKL from Kindergarten onwards. In addition we offer children whose families do not live in the region of Kuala Lumpur the option to stay at our supervised accommodation in Petaling Jaya.
