Dear Parents and Teachers, dear Students,

The last few weeks were marked by the final exams of our Abitur and Realschule graduates. All students passed the exams and some of them with excellent results. For example, one of the Abitur students achieved the best result since the beginning of the Abitur examinations at the DSKL. Congratulations to all of them and we are looking forward to celebrating the results at the graduation ball next Saturday at the Melia Hotel KL.

But also many other things took place at the DSKL in these last weeks: A successful fundraising run with great results was organised - more about that in the following section -, the 9th graders were able to

gain new experiences during their two-week internship and for the parents of our youngest students, who will start in the new first grade in August, an information evening about their childrens' upcoming start of school took place. In general, our preschoolers are currently preparing intensively for the transition to our new first grade. Last week they visited class 4 for a reading morning and also had a look into the current class 1 to get an impression of the upcoming school life. We are looking forward to welcoming seven of our current preschoolers as well as some more new students in our new class 1 next year.

Fantastic results achieved at the sponsored run "Run for Peace" at the DSKL

The school management, the sports department and the student council would like to thank everyone who participated in the "Run for Peace" fundraising run as runners, donors, organisers, helpers or at the stalls.

The run was a great success for everyone involved. The good atmosphere throughout the day and especially the great performances and results were impressive. According to the current status of the donations (we are still waiting for individual amounts), all participants together raised a total of **RM 20,961.00**. A wonderful result indeed and above all a nice contribution to help the needy in their distress.

As we have already informed you, half of the sum will go to various peace projects of the International Red Cross. The other half will go to the aid organisation "Ukraine-Hilfe" run by Jana Reyer. Jana Reyer is a former student of the DSKL who initiated this aid. Last week Jana Reyer visited us and presented her aid project to the students of class 10 in a lecture. After the summer holidays, she will be able to tell us again about her project and the concrete use of our donations.

DSKL Summer Party

In the last newsletter, we announced that we would finally be celebrating a summer festival with the whole school community again this school year. The date is Saturday, June 25th, 2022 and the party will start at 4.00 p.m. on the school grounds of the DSKL. Beforehand, at 3.00 p.m., an ecumenical service of the Catholic and Protestant parishes will take place in the theatre room of the DSKL, to which you are also cordially invited.

Entertainment is provided for this afternoon. The students have prepared a number of programme items for you, the school band will perform their new songs, and the AGs will prepare a number of performances and exhibitions. Another musical programme is planned as well as a bouncy castle for our children and many other surprises. Class 11 will be running the drinks bar that afternoon, selling cool drinks and coffee.

Visitors to the festival are asked to bring a food donation for the large potluck buffet. This can be placed on the buffet table on arrival. A list has already been sent out by the Parents' Council in all class chats and by e-mail. In addition, the baking master will again be present with his popular sausage stand.

We look forward to welcoming you all to the summer festival and to celebrating a wonderful festival with the whole school community.
