Last day of school on Friday, July 1st, 2022

After two years of pandemic, we would like to resume a nice tradition and have breakfast together on the last day of school before the holidays - students, teachers and assistants. After the usual start of school on this day at the first and second lesson in the classroom with the class teacher, the buffet is set up in the entrance area of the school. A short speech follows and then it begins, the DSKL end-of-year breakfast - designed by the culinary delicacies brought by the classes, organised by the SV, and towards the end also the framework for saying goodbye to all the students, teachers and assistants who are leaving the DSKL this summer. Orientation Day in the Kindergarten and School

We cordially invite all new families to the orientation day in the Kindergarten on Thursday, 11.08.2022 from 11.00 - 12.00 hrs. The orientation day at school will take place on Friday, 12.08.2022 from 14.00 - 16.00. On this occasion, the new families can visit the kindergarten or the school again, get to know the teachers and educators, clarify last organisational matters, buy the school uniforms and much more.

The orientation day at the school begins on Friday at 2 p.m. with a short information session in the theatre room. Afterwards, the new families can take care of all other organisational matters individually and get to know the colleagues and other parents and students.

Our Parent Council and the GSSKL (German Speaking Society of Kuala Lumpur) will also be present at the orientation day to welcome the new families. If other parents and students are free that Friday, they are also welcome to attend. The new classmates and their families will certainly be happy if other contact persons are available to answer questions.

First day of school after the holidays on Monday, August 15th, 2022

School starts after the summer holidays on Monday, 15.08.2022, at 8.00 a.m. for classes 2 - 12 and in the Kindergarten. Afternoon lessons will take place according to the new timetables from the first day of school, but not the AGs in the school. These will only start on Monday, 29.08.2022. The school buses will, however, be in operation as usual from the first day of school.

Book distribution procedure

On the first day of school, the school books and materials for the primary school and secondary levels I and II are handed out to the students in the classrooms. Changes in the serving of lunch from the new school year onwards

Our primary school children will start their lunch break a little earlier than the older students in order to spread out the food distribution and to give all children enough time to choose and pay for their meal.

Covid-19 vaccination certificates

To complete our records, please send us a copy or screenshot of the digital vaccination certificate from the MySejahtera app after your child's second Covid vaccination as well as after a booster vaccination. We would also like to point out that the vaccination is not compulsory for school attendance.

Please send us the current passport and visa copies of your children

We would like to remind you once again to please send us the current passport and visa copies of your children, as these are urgently needed for administrative purposes. The school is required to keep these documents up to date. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
